Clinton County will be hosting a Private Pesticide Applicator Recertification Program (PARP) on Thursday, March 19 from 6:30-8:30 PM. The program will be held at the Extension Office, 1111 S Jackson St.

The program will include John Obermeyer from Purdue presenting an Insect & Insect Control Update, Glenn Nice from Purdue presenting a Weed & Weed Control Update, and myself discussing the Sensitive Crop Registry. The program's also been approved for 2 CCH's for category 1. If any CCA's attend I can apply for CEU's after the fact.

Please bring your Applicators license with you to this program. If you do not bring your license, I can register you with your social security card but it's a longer process.

At the bottom of this letter I've listed your recertification status as of February 27. Keep in mind that you must attend three programs prior to your license expiration date and no more than two in the same calendar year.
