- WHAT:** An **Indiana Pesticide Clean Sweep Project** designed to collect and dispose of suspended, canceled, banned, unusable, opened, unopened or just unwanted pesticides (weed killers, insecticides, rodenticides, fungicides, miticides, etc.) is being sponsored by the Office of Indiana State Chemist (OISC). This disposal service is free of charge up to 250 pounds per participant. Over 250 pounds there will be a \$2.00 per pound charge. This is a great opportunity for you to legally dispose of unwanted products at little or not cost.
- WHO:** All public and private schools, golf courses, nurseries, cities, towns, municipalities, county units of government, farmers, agriculture dealers, licensed pesticide businesses or others receiving this notice are eligible to participate.
- WHEN:** 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., local time.
- WHERE:** August 3 - Knox County Fairgrounds, Bicknell, Indiana
August 5 - Tippecanoe County Fairgrounds, Lafayette, Indiana
August 10 - Laporte County Fairgrounds, Laporte, Indiana
August 12 - Fayette County Fairgrounds, Connersville, Indiana
- HOW:** Click **HERE** to open the Pesticide Clean Sweep Planning Form. Complete it to the best of your ability. Mail, fax to 765-494-4331 or e-mail the completed form to Kevin Neal at nealk@purdue.edu **no later than Tuesday, July 27, 2010**. Then bring your labeled, leak-free and safe to transport containers to the collection site. **DO NOT mix materials**. In the case of an emergency, you should bring with you a list of products you are carrying and a contact phone number.
- *NOTE:** *OISC reserves the right to cancel this Pesticide Clean Sweep Project if there is not adequate demand. Participants submitting the planning form by July 27, 2010 will be contacted immediately if cancellation is necessary.*
